Amadeus & Friends is a timeless classic that was originally designed and taught by Connie Ann Root in 1994 for her EGA chapter, Corning. Some fifteen years later nostalgia crept in and Connie was invited once again to share her classic design for canvas. Members who hadn't finished it in 1994 joined new members as they began their own Amadeus & Friends journey which uses the ever popular Jean Hilton stitches, hence the name.

The 27-page pattern is full of comprehensive illustrations and instructions where Connie has combined stitches with a wide variety of thread textures and some open canvas to create a piece with a great deal of visual interest. The stitcher will lend her own creativity to this 8" square design by selecting her own colors of mono canvas, Watercolours, #5 Pearl cotton, Rachel and Kreinik #8 braid.

In celebration of Connie Ann Root's life and in recognition of her dedication to the EGA, her love of embroidery, and her outstanding teaching and design skills, Corning Chapter offers her design so others embroidery enthusiasts can appreciate canvas work as much as she did.
