

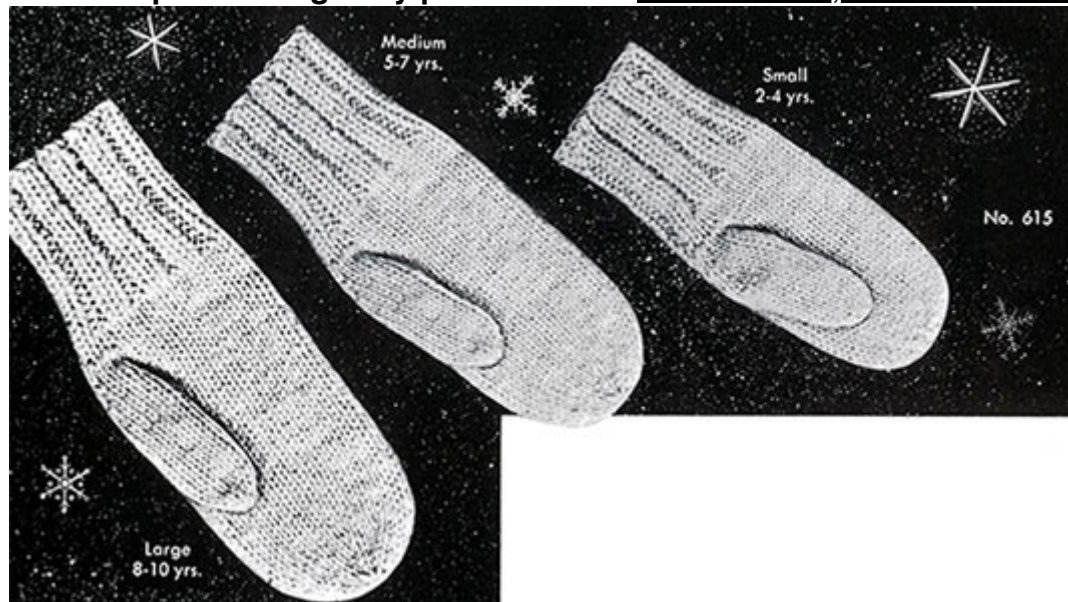


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Classic Mittens Pattern #615

This free pattern originally published in: [Bernhard #29, Gloves and Mittens](#)



Classic Mittens: Use instructions as given.

Striped Mittens: Use same instructions, working 2 rounds or 2 rows of each of 2 or more colors.

Children's Snowman Mittens: Use same instructions and embroider snowman with Angora on back.

Women's Mittens may be trimmed with colored sequins and beads or as desired.

MATERIALS: Fleisher's or Bear Brand Twin-Pak Knitting Worsted; or Fleisher's or Bear Brand Twin-Pak Win-Knit

ozs	2	2	2	2½	3
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“Boye” Knitting Needles, 1 set Sock Needles, Size 4 for Four Needle Mittens: or 1 pair Size 4 for Two-Needle Mittens.

GAUGE: 6 sts = 1 inch; 9 rounds or rows = 1 inch

FOUR NEEDLE MITTENS

CUFF: Cast on and divide on 3 needles	sts	32	36	40	44	48
Join. Work k 2, p 2 ribbing for	ins	2½	2½	3	3	3½
decreasing in last round	sts	1	2	2	2	-
There will be	sts	31	34	38	42	48
Hand: K even for	rounds	3	3	3	4	4
First inc. round for thumb gore: Inc. 1 st in first st (first thumb st), k 1, inc. 1 st in next st (last thumb st), k to end of round	sts	33	36	40	44	50
K 2 rounds even.						
2nd inc. round: Inc. 1 st in first st, k 3, inc. 1 st in next st, k to end	sts	35	38	42	46	52
Continue to inc. 1 st in first and in last thumb st every 3rd round	times	2	2	3	4	5
having 2 sts more between incs. after each inc. round	sts	39	42	48	54	62
K 2 rounds even. Slip to a strand of yarn the thumb	thumb sts	11	11	13	15	17
At end of last round, cast on	sts	2	2	2	3	3
There will be on needles	sts	30	33	37	42	48
Work even until measurement above cuff is	ins	4	4¾	5¼	6	6¾
or to desired length allowing for finishing	ins	½	¾	¾	1	1¼
decreasing in last round	sts	2	1	1	2	-
First dec. round: K tog. every 3rd and 4th st	times	7	8	9	10	12
K even	rounds	1	2	2	3	4
2nd dec. round: K tog. every 2nd and 3rd st	times	7	8	9	10	12
K even	rounds	-	1	1	3	4
3rd dec. round: K 2 tog. in succession	times	7	8	9	10	12
Break off, leaving an end. Draw end tightly through all sts. Fasten off.						
Thumb: Slip to 2 needles the	thumb sts	11	11	13	15	17
with a 3rd needle pick up and k on the cast-on sts	sts	2	2	2	3	3

There will be on 3 needles for thumb	sts	13	13	15	18	20
K around until thumb measures above cast-on sts	ins	1¼	1½	1¾	2	2½
decreasing in last round	sts	1	1	-	-	2
First dec. round: * K 1, k 2 tog.; repeat from *	times	3	3	4	5	5
K even	rounds	1	1	1	2	2
K 2 tog. in succession	times	4	4	5	6	6
Finish as for top of mitten. Make other mitten in same way. Steam.						

TWO NEEDLE MITTENS

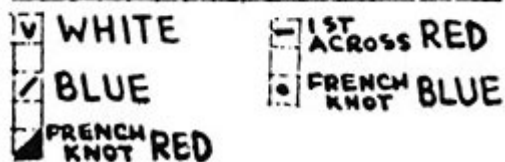
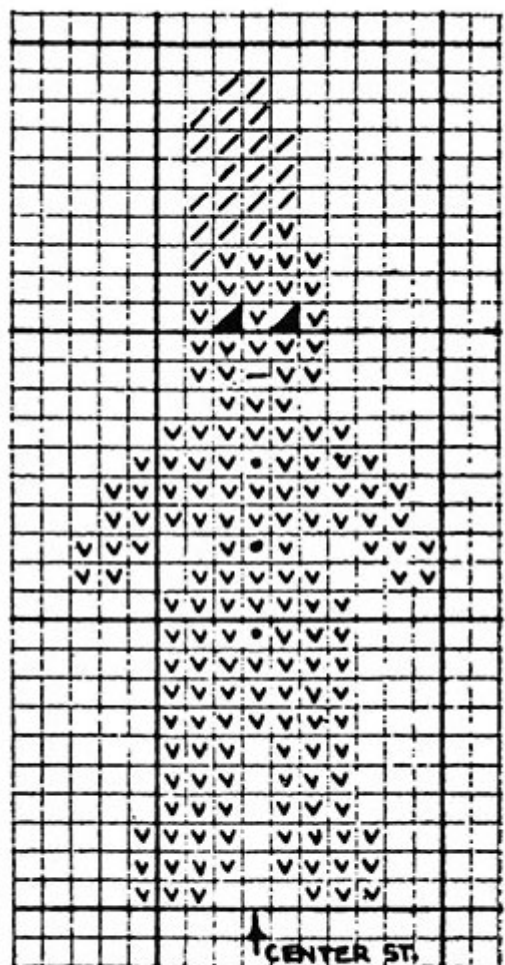
Right Mitten: Cuff: Cast on	sts	32	36	40	44	48
Work k 2, p 2 ribbing for	ins	2½	2½	3	3	3½
decreasing in last row	sts	1	2	2	2	-
There will be	sts	31	34	38	42	48
Hand: Beg. with k row, work stockinette as for	rows	4	4	4	-	-
First inc. row for thumb gore: right side: K	sts	15	17	19	21	24
inc. 1 st in next st (first thumb st), k 1, inc. 1 st in next st (last thumb st), k remaining	sts	13	14	16	18	21
Work even	rows	1	1	1	3	3
2nd inc. row: K	sts	15	17	19	21	24
inc. 1 st in next st, k 3, inc. 1 st in next st, k to end	sts	35	38	42	46	52
Continue to inc. 1 st in first and in last thumb st	every	2nd row	2nd row	2nd row	4th row	4th row
having 2 sts more between incs. after each inc. row	times	2	2	3	4	5
Work even (end with p row)	rows	3	3	5	1	1
on	sts	39	42	48	54	62
Dividing row: right side: K and place on holder for back of hand	sts	15	17	19	21	24
k for thumb	sts	11	11	13	15	17
place on holder for palm	sts	13	14	16	18	21
Thumb: Turn, p thumb sts, cast on loosely	sts	2	2	2	3	3
Continue stockinette st on	sts	13	13	15	18	20

until thumb measures above cast-on sts	ins	1¼	1½	1¾	2	2½
end with p row, decreasing across last row	sts	1	1	-	-	2
First dec. row: * K 1, k 2 tog.; repeat from *	times	3	3	4	5	5
P 1 row. Next row: K 2 tog. in succession	times	4	4	5	6	6
Break off, leaving an end. Draw end tightly through all sts. Fasten securely. Sew thumb seam. Take up sts of back of hand,						
join yarn in last st, pick up and k	sts	2	2	2	3	3
on cast-on thumb sts, take up and k sts of palm, having	sts	30	33	37	42	48
Work even until measurement above cuff is	ins	4	5	5½	6	7
or to desired length allowing for finishing	ins	½	½	½	1	1
end with p row, decreasing in last row	sts	2	1	1	2	-
First dec. row: K tog. every 3rd and 4th st	times	7	8	9	10	12
Work even	rows	1	1	1	3	3
2nd dec. row: K tog. every 2nd and 3rd st	times	7	8	9	10	12
Work even	rows	1	1	1	3	3
3rd dec. row: K 2 tog. in succession	times	7	8	9	10	12
Finish as for thumb. Sew side seam.						
LEFT MITTEN: Work same as right mitten to first inc. row	sts	31	34	38	42	48
First inc. row for thumb gore: right side: K for palm	sts	13	14	16	18	21
inc. 1 st in next st (first thumb st), k 1, inc. 1 st in next st (last thumb st); k for back of hand	sts	15	17	19	21	24
Continue to correspond to right mitten to dividing row, end with p row.						
Dividing row: K sts of palm and place on holder, k next	sts	11	11	13	15	17
of thumb, place on holder for back of hand remaining	sts	15	17	19	21	24
Cast on loosely	sts	2	2	2	3	3
P thumb sts	sts	13	13	15	18	20

Finish to correspond to right mitten.
Steam.
